

**JGFF    USE OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES**

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There is a need for some students to drive motorized vehicles to school. There is also a need for safety regulations governing the use of such motorized vehicles on or near school property. The superintendent shall formulate plans and procedures regulating the driving, parking and use of student motorized vehicles during the school day. Failure of student drivers to observe the district's regulations governing student use of motorized vehicles may result in disciplinary action.

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All rules and regulations concerning use of motorized vehicles on high school property will be submitted to the board for approval.

All such rules and regulations will be given annually to each student driver and his/her parents.

Such rules and regulations shall include but will not be limited to the following:

Students who are observed driving recklessly on or near school property will be reported by any district employee to the high school principal. The principal will warn the driver in the incident at the first opportunity thereafter, and a written notice will be mailed to the parents of the driver;

After a second warning, the student will be reported to the local civil authorities; and

Further violation of these rules and regulations may result in disciplinary action by the school pursuant to the disciplinary code.

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
