

Regional Solo and Ensemble Music Festival Saturday, April 14, 2018 Barton County Community College, 245 NE 30th Road, Great Bend Information for Beloit High School Music Department

Information and Instructions:

There will be a concession stand next to the large gym. Cinnamon rolls and other breakfast items will be available. Pizza rolls, sub sandwich, Rice Krispy treats, chips candy, fruit, bananas, juice, water, and pop. No coffee or tea will be available. The concession stands will be open from 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM. No food or drinks will be allowed outside of the concession area. The cafeteria will be open for lunch between 11:30 AM and 12:30 PM, the cost of the meal is \$5.00+ per person. The cafeteria does not take credit cards. Plan ahead and let your teacher know if you will plan to eat in the cafeteria as we must let the food service know how many to expect. Great Bend is 5 miles away, there may or may not be time for a bus to take students into town for lunch.

There will be no homerooms assigned this year. The main gym will be used as the "homeroom" area; a section of the gym may be marked for our school. **Stay off the gym floor**. The practice gym will not be available to use for practice area. We will not be able to use the practice rooms due to soundproofing problems near the performance areas. **You must remain quiet in the hallway adjacent any performance area!** Weight Rooms and the Pool will be locked down and no one is allowed in this area due to liability.

Any students caught vandalizing the school will be dealt with immediately and turned over to campus security!

We would prefer that all students ride the bus or school suburban to Great Bend. <u>Students may ride to and</u> /or return to Beloit with their parents only if they bring a note to Ms. Deal, Mrs. Vetter or Mr. Harbaugh by <u>THURSDAY, April 12</u>. <u>We will leave Beloit Jr-Sr. High School at 5:30 AM on Saturday morning. The bus will</u> return after all performances are completed and all ratings and awards have been received by the teachers. <u>We</u> must leave on time as early performers will need time to warm-up and prepare for their performances!

Band and Orchestra students: Concert uniforms for soloists. Please return the uniform to Mr. Harbaugh (put it in the suburban or bus) before you leave.

Students performing in Solo Events must have music for the judge. <u>The music must have the measures</u> <u>numbered and marked with the students name, instrument or voice, grade, and school name on the page and cover if a book is used</u>. Any event using photocopied music will be disqualified. The policy is to have the *director* give your music to the door monitor. They will in turn take the music to the judges table and pull the appropriate adjudicators sheet. The music teachers will make sure to have judge's copies, marked and numbered.

RATINGS: Students should keep in mind that their goal should be to perform to the best of their capability. Only performances that are considered "excellent" in all areas are assigned to the First Division of "I" rating. "I" ratings are difficult to come by and should not be expected if one area of the performance is not considered to be "excellent". Ratings will be posted only in the gym area.

DIRECTIONS: Barton County Community College is located on NE 30 Road which is north east of Great Bend. There are two ways to reach the college, on highway 156 from Claflin, turn right at the "Barton Billboard" which appears to be 3 to 5 miles north of the 156 / 56 junction. (Highway 281 north of Russell is closed). Travelling north on 281 which is also Main street turn right at the "Barton Billboard" which is NE 30th Road. I hope this helps!

Only personal stereos with headphones will be allowed on the bus. Thank you for all your efforts to make this an excellent festival!

JUDGES, STUDENTS, PARENTS, FRIENDS, RELATIVES, OBSERVERS, AND DIRECTORS:

No individual shall negatively confront an adjudicator during a music festival. An infraction by a student performer will result in disqualification and loss of award. An

infraction by a director or observer shall result in a letter of reprimand sent to the school's administrator by KSHSAA. Judges are asked to not speak to participants, parents, and directors while the festival is in progress. Please do not put them in an awkward position by asking what a students rating will be or making any other positive or negative comment. The festival may not be over even though our events have completed. The teacher may thank the adjudicator for his or her time and comments after the festival have concluded.
